A PROCLAMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL LETTER WRITING WEEK

WHEREAS, knowledge of the ways and lives of the other peoples of the world increases understanding among nations; and

WHEREAS, all channels of communication must be utilized to achieve better mutual understanding; and

WHEREAS, contact between individuals by letter is an especially effective means of communication for nations as well;

THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 6-12, 1957 as

INTERNATIONAL LETTER WRITING WEEK

in Minnesota and urge all citizens of the state to write letters to friends in other nations and thus act as ambassadors of good will among nations.
