PETITION.

To the Honorable County Board of the County of Hubbard, State of Minnesota:

We, the undersigned petitioners, hereby respectfully represent that the following facts are true, to-wit:

1st. That the undersigned petitioners and all of them are legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, being a portion of the Town of Akeley, in said County of Hubbard.

2d. That your petitioners between the 1st day of December, 1916, and the 5th day of December, 1916, and within eight weeks prior to the presentation of this petition to the County Board, have caused to be taken an accurate census of the resident population of the territory hereinafter described, and that the number of actual residents thereon and therein at said time, as disclosed by said census, was 1076 and that the number of actual residents now residing within said territory is said number.

3d. That the hereinafter described territory of land embracing 970 and 90/100 acres in extent is wholly within the Town of Akeley, County of Hubbard, and State of Minnesota, and that no part thereof is in any incorporated village; that said district includes within its limits the following described additions which have been platted into lots and blocks and the plats thereof have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of said County of Hubbard, to-wit: Original plat of Akeley, First Addition to Akeley, and Bennett's Addition to Akeley, and that the portion of the district hereinafter described which is not included within said platted territory is adjacent thereto, and that said district and all thereof is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

4th. The territory hereinbefore named and referred to is described and bounded as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the South West quarter of Section Twenty-seven (27) in Township One hundred forty one (141) north of Range Thirty two (32) west according to the United States government survey thereof in said Town of Akeley, thence running westerly a distance of one and one-fourth miles, more or less, to the south west corner of the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty eight (28) in said Township and Range; thence running north on the eighth line a distance of two hundred seventy five rods, more or less, to the place where said eighth line intersects the meandered line of 11th Crow Wing lake, so called, said point being the northwest corner of Lot two of said section twenty eight; thence running in a general easterly and northeasterly direction along the meandered line of said lake to the place where said meandered line intersects the north line of Lot numbered four in section twenty two in said township and range; thence running easterly a distance of ninety rods, more or less, to the center of said section twenty two; thence running due southerly to the southeast corner of the South West quarter of Section twenty seven in said township and range, the point of beginning, said territory including in its limits 970 and 90/100 acres of land.

1st. That the undersigned petitioners and all of them are legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, being a portion of the Town of Akeley, in said County of Hubbard.

2nd. That your petitioners between the first day of December, 1915, and the 5th day of December, 1916 and within eight weeks prior to the presentation of this petition to the County Board, caused to be taken an accurate census of the resident population of the territory hereinafter described, and that the number of actual residents herein and therein at said time, as disclosed by said census, was 1076 and that the number of actual residents now residing within said territory is said number.

3rd. That the hereinafter territory of land embraces 970 and 90-100 acres in extent is wholly within the Town of Akeley, County of Hubbard and State of Minnesota, and that no part thereof is in any incorporated Village, that said district includes within its limits the following described additions which have been platted into lots and blocks and the plat thereof have been duly filed, legally certified according to the law of the State of Minnesota, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in said County of Hubbard, to wit: Original plat of Akeley, First Addition to Akeley, and Bennett's Addition to Akeley, and that portion of the district hereinafter described which is not included within said platted territory is adjacent thereto, and that said district and all thereof is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

4th. The territory hereinbefore named and referred to is described and bounded as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of section twenty-seven (27) in Township One hundred forty-one (141) north of Range number two (2) west according to the United States Government survey thereof in the said Township of Akeley, thence running westwardly a distance of one and one fourth miles, more or less, to the south west corner of the southwest quarter of section twenty-eight (28) in said Township and Range, thence running north on the eighth line a distance of two hundred seventy-five rods, more or less, to the place where said meandered line intersects the meandered line of 11th Crow Wing Lake, so-called, said point being the northwest corner of lot Two of said Section twenty-eight; thence running in a general easterly and northeasterly direction along the meandered line of said lake to the place where said meandered line intersects the north line of Lot numbered four in Section Twenty-two in said Township and Range; thence running easterly a distance of ninety rods, more or less, to the center of said Section Twenty-two; thence running due south to the south east corner of the southwest quarter of Section Twenty-seven in said Township and Range, the point of beginning, said territory including within its limits 970 and 90-100 acres of land.

Wherefore, petitioners respectfully petition your honorable Board to call an election of the voters residing within said territory, at which the said voters may vote upon the question of incorporating said territory as such village, and that your Board give the proper notices of said election and appoint inspectors therefore, as provided by law.
