

P. D. CREAMER, LAWMAKER, DIES

**St. Paul Legislator
Serving Second Term**

Patrick David Creamer, 56, state representative from St. Paul's 39th legislative district, died Thursday in Veterans hospital after an illness of several weeks.

Mr. Creamer, who described himself as an "independent liberal," was serving his second term in the Minnesota State legislature. He also served in 1947.

He attended St. Thomas academy and Notre Dame university. He was a trainman for Great Northern railroad.

A veteran of World war I, he was a member of American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and Disabled American
