

**SUICIDE OF MAJOR WALKER**

We were astounded to learn, last evening, that Major **L. C. Walker**, Chippewa Agent, committed suicide, it is supposed, on Saturday last, near Monticello. He was last seen alive crossing the ferry at that place, in a deranged state of mind, caused by the recent disturbances at the Agency. His body was found within three miles of Monticello, some sixty rods from the road, lying on the ground, with a pistol in his hand, under him. Major Walker has been a prominent citizen of this State for a number of years, was a member of the Constitutional Convention, and of the first Legislature, and several years Postmaster of St. Anthony. He was about forty years of age, and leaves a very interesting family.
