Braaken received 13 in Hartland, and 1 in the second ward of this city ; T. W. Purdie received 1 in Albert Lea township, 12 in Hartland, 9 in Freeborn, 7 in the second and 2 in the third ward of this city. No returns were received from Freeman, Mansfield, Riceland, and Newry.
