

John A. Johnson Elected Fillmore-Houston Senator

State Representative John A. Johnson, Preston, stepped up the political ladder in Houston and Fillmore counties Tuesday.

He defeated Hughes Meighen, Preston, in the race to fill the unexpired state senate term of the late Henry A. Larson. On the basis of complete returns compiled in the offices of the respective county auditors of Houston and Fillmore counties the vote was: Johnson, 11,019; Meighen, 3,991.

Elected to succeed Johnson as representative-at-large was H. M. Greer, Lanesboro, who polled 7,731 votes in the two counties to the 7,315 garnered by Gerhard Oian, Peterson.
