

Former State Legislator Killed in Auto Accident

Funeral services for Andrew Donovan, Belle Plaine, state representative from Scott county in 1917, who was killed yesterday at Eden Prairie, when his automobile was struck by a Minneapolis and St. Louis passenger train, will be held at Belle Plaine at 10 a. m. tomorrow. Mr. Donovan, who was 52 years old, was proprietor of the Belle Plaine Tile company. He was for many years active in Democratic politics. The force of the collision carried Mr. Donovan's automobile for some distance. He was dead when the train crew and passengers reached him. An investigation has been begun by Dr. C. A. Hobbs, deputy coroner. Mr. Donovan was unmarried but he is survived by a number of relatives at Belle Plaine.
