The official returns of the special election held on Friday in the Western Representative district of this county, were canvassed on Monday by Justices of the Peace, G. W. Siocum, of this place, and W. C. Tibbetts, of Concord, and showed that Geo. Hitchcock was elected by a majority of 118. The vote was a very light one, as will be seen by comparing it with that east for Garfield and Hancock in the same precincts, last fall, as shown in the following table:
