**JOHN B. HOMPE.**

Funeral services for John B. Hompe, 91, a Civil War veteran and former member of the state legislature, who died Wednesday night in the hospital of the Minnesota Old Soldiers' home, will be conducted at Deer Creek, Minn., where he lived all the time he was a legislator. Mr. Hompe, who would have been 92 next February, came to Minnesota in 1876, taking a homestead in Newton township, Otter Tail county. Before that he had lived in New York state and in Michigan. He was formerly a school teacher, farmer and merchant, and was first elected to the legislature from Otter Tail county in 1889. He is survived by four sons, Harold, of Monticello, Minn., and Howard, Bernard and Edward of Deer Creek.
