

Funeral services for Emmett Zimmerman Mark, 73, veteran livestock dealer, legislator, and resident of Minnesota for the past 66 years, who died Friday will be held at 2:30 p. m. today at the Aaron funeral home. 279 West Seventh street, St. Paul.

A son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Aaron Mary lifelong citizens of Minnesota and active workers in Jewish philanthropies, he was widely known over the entire middle west. During the late war he bought carloads of western horses for the French and Italian governments to be shipped overseas for use by the Allied armies.

Elected to the house of representatives in 1901, he served in the 1903 and 1905 sessions of the legislature, the first held in the new capitol.

He is survived by a son, Walter of Willow River, and five sisters, Mrs. Jacob Moses, of Minneapolis, Mrs. Max Mark of Des Moines, Mrs. A. S. Mark of 1132 Laurel avenue, Mrs. Fanny Litman, 524 Dayton avenue, and Mrs. Samuel Rubenstein, 1144 Portland avenue, St. Paul.
