The certificate of Wm. H. Campbell, auditor of Wabashaw county, was received by the secretary of state yesterday, giving the result of the special election held in that county to fill the vacancy in the lower house of the legislature, caused by the resignation of Hon. H. B. McMaster, removed from the state. The vote was: Francis H. Milligan, Democrat, 449; Robt. Van Dyke, Republican, 156; thus electing Mr. Milligan, to whom the certificate was given.
