

Simon Meyers, Veteran Lawyer, Dies at 90

Simon Meyers, 90, believed Minnesota's oldest practicing attorney, died in Minneapolis Monday.

He resided at the Leamington hotel. Mr. Meyers was a Minneapolis resident since 1883.

He was a member of the state legislature in 1897 and had been a vice president of the Cedar Lake Ice & Fuel Co. He was one of the founders of the Oak Ridge Country club and was a member of Hennepin County Bar association and Temple Israel.

Survivors include his wife, Minnie; a son, Henry L., Minneapolis; a daughter, Mrs. Leonard H. Heller, St. Paul; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at Temple Israel.
