## ONE VACANCY IN STATE HOUSE NOW ASSURED

P. A. Peterson's Seat Is Not to Be Filled This Session, According to Dispatch From St. Paul.

St. Paul, Feb. 28—The Minnesota House of Representative will go through the rest of its forty-eighth legislative session with one vacancy, the lower branch decided Monday.

It passed a bill previously approved by the Senate amending existing laws to obviate the necessity of Freeborn county holding a special election to name a successor to the late Representative P. A. Peterson of Emmons.

Mr. Peterson died recently after a heart attack. The law made a special election mandatory but unt der the amendment now passed by the Legislature Freeborn county will not be put to the added exa pense of naming a successor.
