John Drew, a former state representative and St. Paul City Council member, died Tuesday morning in a St. Cloud hospital four days after suffering a massive heart attack.

Drew, 56, had been unconscious since Friday.

A Republican from St. Paul, Drew was elected to the Legislature in 1978 and again in 1980. In 1983 he won election to the St. Paul City Council, where he represented the Highland Park neighborhood. He was reelected in 1985.

At the time of his death, Drew lived on the west side of Lake Mille Lacs near Garrison, Minn., where he and his wife, Mary, owned the Rainbow Inn resort. They moved there from St. Paul in 1988.
