## Melvin Miller, Randall legislator, dies at 55

Melvin Miller, 55, a DFL state representative from Randall, Minn., died early today in St. Paul after an apparent heart attack in his hotel room.

According to police, Miller's widow, Anne, said her husband awoke about 3 a.m. and complained about the room being hot. Moments later he collapsed in a chair.

St. Paul Fire Department paramedics were called, but Miller was pronounced dead on arrival at St. Paul-Ramsey Hospital. *Mpls. Star*

Miller, a farmer, was elected to his second term Nov. 5, defeating Bruce Nelsen, a son of congressman Ancher Nelsen.

Gov. Wendell Anderson will set a special election to fill Miller's seat.
