Former state Rep. August Mueller dies at 91; spent 31 years in House

ARLINGTON, MINN. — August (Augie) Mueller, 91, who served in the Minnesota House of Representatives for three decades, died Sunday at Community Hospital in Arlington.

Mueller, a cattle farmer, represented Sibley and parts of McLeod and Nicollet counties in south-central Minnesota from 1941 to 1972.

He was chairman of the Highways Committee from 1963

through the 1969 session. Mueller served in the Legislature before lawmakers were affiliated with parties; although he caucused with the conservatives.

Mueller was born in Arlington Township and attended St. Olaf College.

He ran the farm with his brother and was known for his support of amateur baseball.
