5 WHEREAS, Carl M. Iverson was born in Grant County,
6 Minnesota, on April 6, 1894; and,

7 WHEREAS, Carl M. Iverson attended the country school in
8 Grant County, graduated from Moorhead State Normal School, and
9 studied agriculture at the University of Minnesota; and,

10 WHEREAS, Carl M. Iverson took over his parents' farm and
11 operated it until recently and was the general manager of the
12 Farmer's Produce Cooperative Association from its inception
13 until he died; and,

14 WHEREAS, Carl M. Iverson was elected from Grant County to
15 the old 48th district of the House of Representatives of the
16 State of Minnesota and served there continuously from 1918 until
17 1930, served in the Senate from 1930 to 1934, and again served
18 in the House from 1939 until 1966; and

19 WHEREAS, during his forty-four years of service in the
20 House of Representatives and Senate he was a much respected
21 member of the legislature known for his oratorical skill and
22 remembered as one of the best orators ever to serve in the
23 legislature; and,

24 WHEREAS, Carl M. Iverson authored many bills to assist the

1 cooperative movement and was an expert in legislative
2 reapportionment; and,

3 WHEREAS, he was the principal author of many laws which
4 benefited the people of the State of Minnesota and of Grant
5 County; and,

6 WHEREAS, Carl M. Iverson was a member of the First
7 Presbyterian Church in Ashby, the Ashby Lions Club, the Masons,
8 and Zurah Shrine, and engaged in other work for the betterment
9 of the people of the State of Minnesota; and,

10 WHEREAS, Carl M. Iverson died on February 3, 1981; NOW,
11 THEREFORE,

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State
13 of Minnesota that it commends to the people of the State of
14 Minnesota the record of Carl M. Iverson as a life, work, and
15 spirit worth emulation. It extends its condolences to his
16 relatives and to all the people of Grant County who knew him.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the House of
18 Representatives is directed to prepare an enrolled copy of this
19 resolution, to be authenticated by his signature and that of the
20 Speaker, and to present it to the brother and sister of Carl M.
21 Iverson.
