15th district—Nicollet county

Rep. Harold R. Anderson is one of the band of younger house conservatives with a streak of liberal Republicanism woven through his political thinking.



Anderson is in his fifth term as Nicollet county's representative. He has played strong roles in legislative battles—futile, so far—for such things as reapportionment, constitutional revision and party designation for legislators. *Mpls. Star*

He is a building contractor at North Mankato, active in community life. He belongs to the Masons, Elks, Lions, American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars. Anderson and his wife belong to the Methodist church.

Anderson had an active 4-H club career for 10 years, winning four state and two national championships along the way. He is a graduate of Gustavus Adolphus college and the University of Minnesota.

He went into agricultural work as a county agent before enlisting for army duty that took him to Italy, France and Germany.

Anderson has been serving on interim commissions on state building needs and recodification of education laws.
