Sen. Joseph Vadheim carries a name well known in Minnesota drug and medical circles.

The senator is a druggist long active in the Minnesota State Pharmaceutical association and brother of one of southern Minnesota's better known veteran doctors. His wife, son and daughter also are registered pharmacists.

1960? Vadheim, 63, is a South Dakota native but was raised and schooled at Tyler, where he has lived most of his life. He graduated from Tyler high school and received his pharmacy degree from the University of Minnesota.

He has owned his drugstore at Tyler since 1919, right after he was mustered out of the first World War. He belongs to the American Legion which he has served as post commander in addition to being service officer for 20 years.

He has served three terms as Tyler village councilman and two as mayor, is a past president of the state pharmaceutical association and a member of its executive board for six years.

He belongs to the Kiwanis and Commercial clubs at Tyler and the Lutheran church, at which he has taught Sunday school for more than a quarter of a century.

Vadheim and his wife are the parents of a son, ^{Roger} Joseph, and a daughter, Beth.
