Back for his 10th term—he was unopposed—as Carver county's house member, Ottinger again can be counted on to influence welfare legislation. Welfare committee chairman for three sessions under conservative house control, he stayed on the committee under liberal control in 1955. *Mpls. Star*

His background led to his appointment to the interim committee studying welfare laws, which in turn elected him chairman. Included in Ottinger's background are many sessions of duty on the house appropriations committee that must match funds against welfare needs.
