Ogle began distinguishing himself in community life in Mankato, his home town, shortly after his return from bombing pilot duty in World War II. He was Blue Earth March of Dimes chairman from 1946 to 1954, active in Junior Chamber of Commerce work and in 1952 was named Minnesota Jaycee president.

He is a former member of the Mankato charter commission and was on the Mankato city planning commission until his election to the house two years ago. He is vice chairman of the Blue Earth county Republican committee.

He is married and the father of two children.

Ogle belongs to the First Presbyterian church, the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and Masons. He received his law degree from the University of Minnesota in 1940 and belongs to various bar associations.
