

Joseph Coduti, state employee 30 years, dies

Joseph A. Coduti, 70, 4712 Isabel Av. S., a retired assistant state attorney general and a former legislator, died Sunday. Services will be at 10 a.m. Thursday in Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, Hibbing, Minn.

Before retirement last September, Mr. Coduti was an assistant attorney general assigned to the Department of Employment Security and for part of his 30 years as a state employee was in the Department of Labor and Industry.

He was elected to the Minnesota House in 1934 while practicing law in Hibbing and attended one regular legislative session and three special sessions.

Surviving are his widow, Adeline; two daughters, Mrs. Peter Morgan and Paula Coduti, both of Bloomington; a brother, Leo, Kingsburg, Calif., and three sisters, Mrs. Christine Lind, Minneapolis, Mrs. Ross Vallinger, Venice, Fla., and Mrs. Mary Dooley, Roanoke, Va.
