**REP. J. J. KELLY**

13th district—Lyon county

New Lyon county house member and by the margin of an election recount is Rep. J. J. Kelly of Marshall.

Kelly beat incumbent Ralph Madden by a margin of but two votes, on the first count. Then by 128 votes in the recount.



A veterinarian by profession, Kelly presently is president of Minnesota Veterinary Medical society. He was born at Manteno, Ill., attended high school and two years at the University of Notre Dame, then received his degree from McKillip Veterinary college. *Mpls. Star*

In World War I he served with the veterinary medical corps and was veterinarian for the 13th division.

He is a member of the Catholic church, belongs to the Knights of Columbus and various local civic organizations. Kelly has been an active participant in Lyon county DFL work, is chairman of the county's DFL committee and intends to caucus with the house liberal majority.

Kelly is a widower.
