Elsie Kelley Lindquist

Elsie Kelley Lindquist, 68, died Thursday of a cerebral hemorrhage. She was the wife of a prominent Minneapolis attorney, Leonard Lindquist.

Mrs. Lindquist, a lifelong resident of Minneapolis, worked with the Red Cross during World War II in London and France. She was active later in Twin Cities civic and community affairs.

Her husband is the senior partner in the Lindquist and Vennum law firm. He served in the Minnesota House of Representatives and the old Railroad and Warehouse Commission. In 1958 he was defeated for the Third District congressional seat.

She is survived by her husband and three sons, Lowell, Lawrence and Kelley, all of Minneapolis. Reviewal will be held today from 4 to 8 p.m. at the Welander-Quist-Davies Mortuary, 2301 Dupont Av. S. Funeral services are scheduled for noon Saturday at the Hennepin Avenue United Methodist Church, Groveland and Lyndale Aves. S. Burial will be in the Fort Snelling National Cemetery.
