Johns'n, a Republican, was elected to the Minnesota House of Representatives for five terms, from 1943 hrough 1948 and from 1955 thrown 1958.

Canson studied embalming at the University of Minnesota and Toulded the Johnson Funeral Hope in McGregor. He was past preident of the Minnesota Funeral Directors Association and helped wife the state laws for licensing furral directors.

Helso founded and developed the Pilland Telephone Co. in McGrego and served on the McGregor Bord of Education for 33 years.

Johson is survived by three sons; Clyle and Warren of McGregor and Richard of Eau Claire, Wis.; a steisister, Jessie Robertson of Terle Haute, Ind.; six grandchildren; five stepgrandchildren, and wogreat-grandchildren.
