SUBJECT: D. S. Feidt

Daniel S. Feidt was born in 1908 and raised in Minneapolis, where he lived until 1972, when he moved to Key Biscayne, Florida.

Mr. Feidt, an attorney, was elected to the Minnesota House of Representatives in 1936, as a conservative. In 1938 he was elected to the State Senate, where he served until 1961. For a time he headed the Hennepin County Senate Delegation. Among his major interests while in the Senate, was juvenile delinquency.

In 1959, he and several other local businessmen formed Twin City Lines, the company that took over the Twin City Rapid Transit Company. He later became President of Minnesota Enterprises, Inc.

He was a former President of the Minnesota Jaycees and of the Hennepin County Medical Board, as well as Executive Secretary of the Minnesota Bar Association.

On January 19, 1973, Daniel Feidt died of cancer, leaving his wife, two sons and a daughter as survivors.
