Grussing was born on a farm near Clara City 51 years ago and was a farmer until about 12 years ago, when he moved into town and launched his present contracting business.

He was educated in country schools in Chippewa county but he and wife, Anna, saw to it that their two sons received better schooling. One son, Paul, graduated as a pharmacist from the University of Minnesota and is now in the army medical corps, serving at Frankfurt, Germany.

Roger, their second son, is a sophomore at Macalester college.

Grussing considers himself a political independent but caucuses with the house conservative minority.
