REP. CARL G. HAGLAND

Minneapolis' 31st district

Rep. Carl G. Hagland is a veteran of 20 years' service as representative from the 31st district in Minneapolis and unchallenged dean of the Hennepin county liberals in the house.



He was born in the district he represents, attended South Hagland high school and belongs to a number of fraternal and civic organizations, including the Eagles, Masons and South Side Businessmen's association. He is a member of the Lutheran church.

Hagland, 58, is a tile setter by trade and has served as business representative for their union. He has held similar posts with the Minneapolis Building Trades council and the AFL City and County employes' union.

In the 1955 legislature Hagland was chairman of the general legislation committee of the house and served on the commercial transportation, motor vehicles, public institutions, university and tax committees. *Mpls. Star*
