

Former legislator William Heuer dies

Services will be held Monday at the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Bertha, Minn., for former state Senator William C. F. Heuer, 69, who died yesterday. *7-18-1975*

Heuer, a DFLer, represented District 51 in Wadena and Todd Counties from 1955 until 1966, when he was defeated. *Mpls-Star*

Heuer then became director of Green View, Inc., a state office in Wadena that hired people to maintain state highway wayside rest areas. He retired last year.

Survivors include his widow, Selma; five sons, Donald, Minneapolis, Gerald and Charles of Moorhead, James, Wadena, and Waldemar, Decatur, Ill.; and three daughters, Maxine Truax and Ramona Truax, both of Bertha, and Caroline of McVillage, Minn.

Visitation is scheduled Sunday from noon to 9 p.m. and Monday from 9 a.m. to noon at the Dominican-Anderson Memorial Home in Bertha. Visitation also will be permitted at the church until the service begins at 2 p.m.
