Rep. Sally Luther has progressed steadily since making her entry into politics eight years ago.

She has won the respect of the otherwise all-male house for her diligence and

has taken on increased responsibilities between sessions. She is a member of the governor's advisory committees on reapportionment and consumer problems.



Mrs. Luther is also regarded as influential in the DFL and has seen duty in party councils.

Mrs. Luther is a member of the Minneapolis charter review committee and has served as a member of the Hennepin county welfare council's committee on relocation problems.

She is a former newspaper reporter, the wife of C. Hamilton Luther, a Minneapolis lawyer.

During the past summer Mrs. Luther and her husband vacationed for three weeks in Europe, observing the British parliament and investigating the Danish public welfare program. She has been chairman of the house welfare committee.

Mrs. Luther, 39, belongs to Westminster Presbyterian church, the American Association of University Women and is a board member of numerous organizations.
