

Ex-GOP legislator G. D. McCarty dies

Glenn D. McCarty, a former Republican state legislator, died yesterday in Abbott Hospital as a result of a heart attack he suffered last week.

McCarty, 61, who lived at 2221 Humboldt Av. S., was in the Minnesota House from 1954 to 1960. In 1960, he was elected to the first of three terms in the Minnesota Senate. In 1972, he lost the Republican Party endorsement for the Senate race after redistricting and did not run for reelection.

He was chairman of the Senate Labor Relations committee during the 1971 session.

Services will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday at Werness Brothers Mortuary, 50th St. and Beard Av. S., with burial in Waukon, Iowa.
