## McKnight Tower to be dedicated

A 39-story apartment building, the tallest of the 13 buildings being completed at 5th St. and Cedar Av. S., will be dedicated Friday noon and named the Henry T. McKnight Tower.

Mr. McKnight, a former state senator and conservationist, was board chairman of Cedar-Riverside Associates Inc. and of the Tonathan Development Corp. in Chaska. He died Dec. 30 at the age of 59.

McKnight Tower, the seventh tallest building in Minneapolis, is part of the initial stage of the nation's first federally designated 'new town in-town.' The dedication will be attended by about 80 people here for the meeting of the League of New Community Developers.
