

Henry L. Morin Dies at Duluth

DULUTH — (AP) — Henry L. Morin, 60, former state senator from the 59th district, Duluth, died Monday.

Morin, who operated a truck farm at Aitkin, was a guest at the Minnesota Federation of Labor convention here when he was stricken. He was dead on arrival at a Duluth hospital.

Cause of death was not learned immediately.

Morin was a state senator from 1922 to 1934, when he was defeated by Homer Carr, Proctor.

Morin was active in labor circles, drafting many labor bills in the senate. In 1935 he was named WPA director for Duluth.
