George E. Murk dies; MPla Star 3-25-71 former representative

George E. Murk, 76, who served 18 years in the Minnesota House of Representatives before being defeated in 1962, died Wednesday.

Murk, 4036 NE. Hayes St., Columbia Heights was a Minneapolis fireman from 1917 to 1939. In 1934 he became president and business agent of the Minneapolis Musician's Association, Local 73. He served in the post until 1961.

Murk was on the Minneapolis Charter Commission from 1940 to 1945 when he began the first of eight terms as a representative. He was beaten for reelection in 1955 but returned to the House in 1957. He was a DFLer and represented the 41st District (northeast Minneapolis).

He is survived by his widow, Agnes; a daughter, Mrs. Hame (Lois) Corporaal, Columbia Heights; a son, Harris G., St. Paul; and a brother, Pastor William Murk, St. Paul.
