## Ex-legislator Emil Regnier dies at 78

Emil Regnier, 78, a former Farmer-Labor Party state senator, died Monday in St. Paul.

Regnier represented Lyon and Yellow Medicine counties for two terms, from 1930 to 1934. While in the Legislature, Regnier worked for state ratification of a national amendment to end liquor prohibition, and on legislation that ended mandatory ROTC at the University of Minnesota.

Regnier is survived by his wife, Leone; a son, Pierre, and three daughters, Lenore Augustine, Jeanne Trudeau and Yvonne Eastman, all of St. Paul, and 15 grandchildren.
