

C. J. SALMONSON DIES IN CLINTON

Representative in Legislature
From Big Stone County
Since 1923.

Clinton, Minn., Sept. 19.—Charles J. Salmonson, 74, state representative from Big Stone county since 1923, died at his home near here Monday of pneumonia following an illness of four days.

Representative Salmonson had been in good health until stricken last Thursday. Born on November 24, 1858, he came to Minnesota 53 years ago and homesteaded in Big Stone county. He had farmed there ever since.

First elected to the house of representatives in 1922, Mr. Salmonson had been returned to that post each session since, and he was a candidate for re-election this year. During the 1931 session of the legislature, Representative Salmonson was a member of the following house committees: Agriculture and horticulture; crime prevention, game and fish, military affairs, state prison and temperance.

Surviving are the widow and 10 children. Funeral services will be held probably Wednesday.
