He ran, instead, for the house, where he has steadily gained stature among the ranks of the younger conservatives.

Schulz has farmed just outside of Mankato since he left Mankato junior college, where he starred in sports. For several years he continued mixing sports with farming, pitching for baseball and softball teams in southern Minnesota.

Schulz has carried a variety of committee assignments and in the 1955 session served on the agriculture, game and fish, law enforcement, taxes and university committee.
