Marvin C. Schumann, Rice legislator

Marvin C. Schumann, 88, a legislator from Rice, Minn., for 14 years, died Thursday at Country Manor Health Care & Retirement Center in Sartell, Minn.

Schumann had lived his entire life in Rice, in Benton County, until he moved to Country Manor in 1989.

A Republican member of the Legislature from 1954 to 1968, he was chairman of the Dairy Products and Livestock Committee and Legislative Building Commission. He also served on the Benton County Board for 10 years.

Schumann owned two farms totaling about 700 acres and worked in the livestock and trucking industries for several years. He also was a member, director and president of the Graham Mutual Fire Insurance Co. for 35 years until he retired in 1980.

He was a member of the school board and fire department in Rice, the Lions Club, the American Aberdeen Angus Association and Graham United Methodist Church in Rice.

Schumann is survived by a son, Ivan, of Sauk Rapids, Minn.; two daughters, Julie LaVigne, of Sauk Rapids, and Nancy Hills, of Lake Hubert, Minn.; a brother, Leslie, of Rice, and two sisters, Josephine Hackett, of St. Cloud, Minn., and Lois Scheel, of Rice.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. today at Graham United Methodist Church. Arrangements are by the Dingmann Funeral Home, Sauk Rapids.
