Adding to his experience in various phases of government is Rep. A. O. Sundet, returning for a third term as Rice county representative.

Sundet, 52, lives just outside Faribault and has been a Rice county resident nearly 20 years. He has farmed most of that time, also engaging in sales of insurance and farm machinery and at present owns a Faribault drive-in.

He put in 10 years as chairman of his rural school board, was six years a member of the township board. He's been active in soil conservation program development served on the Rice county selective service board, was president of the county Farm Bureau from 1948 to 1950, and was an adviser to the veterans on-the-farm training program from 1946 to 1952.
