- 1.2relating to education; restricting female sports team participation to the female
- 1.3sex; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 121A.04, by adding a subdivision.
- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 121A.04, is amended by adding a subdivision
- 1.6to read:
- 1.7Subd. 4a. **Female sports teams.** Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, only students
- 1.8of the female sex may participate in an elementary or secondary school level athletic team
- 1.9or sport that an educational institution has restricted on the basis of sex to women or girls.
- 1.10If there is a dispute as to whether a student is of the female sex, the student must present a
- 1.11signed physician's statement indicating the student's sex that is based solely on:
- 1.12(1) the student's internal and external reproductive anatomy;
- 1.13(2) the student's naturally occurring level of testosterone; and
- 1.14(3) an analysis of the student's chromosomes.
- 1.15**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2025.
