- 1.1A bill for an act
- 1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the restoration of the Carver
- 1.3levee in the city of Carver.
- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; CITY OF CARVER.**
- 1.6\$3,350,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
- 1.7of natural resources for a grant to the city of Carver for capital improvements to restore the
- 1.8Carver levee, protecting an important historic district in Minnesota from floodwaters of the
- 1.9Minnesota River. This levee restoration must meet the requirements of Federal Emergency
- 1.10Management Agency (FEMA) certification. The project includes predesign, design,
- 1.11engineering, land acquisition, and construction of capital improvements, including raising
- 1.12the height of the Carver levee, constructing internal drainage, establishing maintainable
- 1.13setbacks to adjacent structures, and certification by FEMA. This appropriation is in addition
- 1.14to the appropriation in Laws 2023, chapter 72, article 1, section 7, subdivision 8, and for
- 1.15the same purpose. This appropriation is onetime and is available until the project is completed
- 1.16or abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.
- 1.17**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
