- 1.8residential program to make food purchases on behalf of a program resident using the
- 1.9resident's electronic benefit transfer (EBT) card, the staff person must be listed as an
- 1.10authorized representative of the resident. A residential program must maintain a log of
- 1.11purchases made by program staff using a resident's EBT card and must retain a record of
- 1.12purchases made under this subdivision according to section 245A.041.
