- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 116.06, is amended by adding a subdivision
- 1.6to read:
- 1.7Subd. 4b. Animal feedlot. (a) "Animal feedlot" means a lot or building or combination
- 1.8of lots and buildings intended for the confined feeding, breeding, raising, or holding of
- 1.9animals:
- 1.10(1) that is specifically designed as a confinement area in which manure may accumulate;
- 1.11or
- 1.12(2) where the concentration of animals is such that a vegetative cover cannot be
- 1.13maintained within the enclosure.
- 1.14(b) Animal feedlot includes open lots used for feeding and rearing poultry, except that
- 1.15a lot with 12 or fewer chickens is not an animal feedlot. Animal feedlot does not include a
- 1.16pasture.
