1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 169.06, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.6to read:

1.7Subd. 6a. **Roundabout.** (a) A road authority, as defined in section 169.224, subdivision

1.81, must not establish a crosswalk within 100 feet of a roundabout.

1.9(b) Paragraph (a) does not apply to a crosswalk that is:

1.10(1) controlled by pedestrian-control signals; or

1.11(2) established prior to the effective date of this section, until reconstruction of the

1.12roundabout or road.
