- 1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6Section 1. [415.20] MUNICIPAL IDS; LIMITATION.
- 1.7Subdivision 1. Definitions. (a) For the purposes of this section, the following terms have
- 1.8the meanings given.
- 1.9(b) "Municipal ID" means a photographic identification card in physical or electronic
- 1.10form created and provided by a municipality to a resident of the municipality that includes
- 1.11the individual's name, date of birth, residential address, and any other identifying information
- 1.12as required or authorized by the municipal ordinance.
- 1.13(c) "Municipality" means a statutory or home rule charter city.
- 1.14(d) "Resident" means a person who resides within the municipality's corporate boundaries
- 1.15for a minimum of 30 continuous days immediately prior to application for a municipal ID
- 1.16and who submits documentation demonstrating identity and residency as required in this
- 1.17section.
- 1.18Subd. 2. Municipal ID; acceptance limited. Notwithstanding any law or rule to the
- 1.19contrary, a municipal ID does not qualify as proof of identification required for the receipt
- 1.20of one or more services provided by the state or through a federal program administered by
- 1.21the state or a political subdivision thereof.
- 1.22EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
