- 1.2relating to health occupations; extending nurse temporary permits from 60 to 90
- 1.3days; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 148.212, subdivision 1.
- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 148.212, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.6Subdivision 1. **Issuance.** Upon receipt of the applicable licensure or reregistration fee
- 1.7and permit fee, and in accordance with rules of the board, the board may issue a nonrenewable
- 1.8temporary permit to practice professional or practical nursing to an applicant for licensure
- 1.9or reregistration who is not the subject of a pending investigation or disciplinary action, nor
- 1.10disqualified for any other reason, under the following circumstances:
- 1.11(a) The applicant for licensure by endorsement under section 148.211, subdivision 2, is
- 1.12currently licensed to practice professional or practical nursing in another state, territory, or
- 1.13Canadian province. The permit is valid until the date of board action on the application or
- 1.14for ~~60~~ 90 days, whichever comes first.
- 1.15(b) The applicant for licensure by endorsement under section 148.211, subdivision 2,
- 1.16or for reregistration under section 148.231, subdivision 5, is currently registered in a formal,
- 1.17structured refresher course or its equivalent for nurses that includes clinical practice.
