Section 1. MINNESOTA-MADE FERTILIZER GRANT PROGRAM.

(a) The commissioner of agriculture must establish and implement the Minnesota-made

fertilizer grant program. The commissioner may award a grant of up to \$..... to an applicant

to manufacture, process, and handle fertilizer while operating in Minnesota. The goal of

the grant program is to increase the supply of fertilizer produced locally.

(b) To be eligible for a grant, an applicant must operate in Minnesota.

(c) Priority must be given to applicants that supply fertilizer to agricultural producers
- 1.12

for use in crop years 2026 and thereafter.
