- 1.8A health plan company must include in the summary of benefits and coverage a statement
- 1.9that indicates whether the health plan company applied money from a patient assistance
- 1.10program, as defined in section 62J.84, subdivision 2, paragraph (h), to an enrollee's
- 1.11deductible.
- 1.12EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2026, and applies to health
- 1.13plans offered, issued, or renewed on or after that date.
