\$15,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 is from the 2.1 state airports fund for system maintenance of 2.2 critical airport safety systems, equipment, and 2.3 essential airfield technology. 2.4 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 2.5 16A.28, subdivision 6, the appropriation from 2.6 the state airports fund is available for five 2.7 years after the year of the appropriation. If the 2.8 appropriation for either year is insufficient, 2.9 the appropriation for the other year is available 2.10 for it. 2.11 If the commissioner of transportation 2.12 determines that a balance remains in the state 2.13 airports fund following the appropriations 2.14 made in this article and that the appropriations 2.15 made are insufficient for advancing airport 2.16 development and assistance projects, an 2.17 amount necessary to advance the projects, not 2.18 to exceed the balance in the state airports fund, 2.19 is appropriated in each year to the 2.20 commissioner and must be spent according to 2.21 Minnesota Statutes, section 360.305, 2.22 subdivision 4. Within two weeks of a 2.23 determination under this contingent 2.24 appropriation, the commissioner of 2.25 transportation must notify the commissioner 2.26 of management and budget and the chairs, 2.27 ranking minority members, and staff of the 2.28 2.29 legislative committees with jurisdiction over transportation finance concerning the funds 2.30 appropriated.
