- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. **[373.52] CONSTITUTIONAL INTEGRITY AND VALUES IN LAW**
- 1.6**(CIVIL) ACT.**
- 1.7(a) This section may be cited as the "Constitutional Integrity and Values in Law (CIVIL)
- 1.8Act."
- 1.9(b) A county may, by resolution, designate itself to be a constitutional county. The chief
- 1.10clerical officer of the county must file the resolution with the secretary of state.
- 1.11(c) A constitutional county may determine to not authorize or appropriate funds,
- 1.12employees, property, or other county resources for the purpose of enforcing any law, rule,
- 1.13or regulation that conflicts with the federal constitution or federal law.
- 1.14**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
